Fall Season: September – December

St Louis Rowing Club Dues

\$450

Dues include full membership to the St. Louis Rowing Club for the fall season (\$275). Membership dues support the maintenance of the rowing facility, insurance, coaches' salaries, and equipment purchase and maintenance. The rest of the dues (\$175 Booster Fee) is set aside to specifically support the Juniors' Program.

The **estimated** cost per out-of-town regatta is \$180. In 2015, all novice rowers will be invited to attend 1 fall regatta. Select novice rowers may be invited to attend a second regatta. Regatta fees may include transportation by bus, hotel, transportation of the boats, entry fees and most meals.

In 2016, all novice rowers will probably be invited to attend 3 out of town spring regattas. This is subject to change. One of the regattas is over 2 nights, which will cause the price of that regatta to be higher than the \$180 estimate.

Approximate Novice cost for the Spring Season

\$1,030

Club dues are due with registration. The details on how to order and pay for uniforms will be provided at a later date. After one year of rowing, if rowers continue with varsity, a traditional rowing uni will be required at an additional cost. Regatta fees are determined prior to the event and are due on the morning of departure. A limited amount of financial assistance is available to assist with club dues for qualified rowers based on financial need.
